How to deal with renal disease.

Patients should limit intake of certain food with high sodium, high protein and fruits. Close control is required for patient with high blood pressure. Medication can help reduce some symptoms but no drug is able to drive waste out of the body. Dialysis is, therefore, the only way to get waste products out of the body. Major

Dialysis cannot cure renal failure.

Dialysis will filter out excessive water and waste products from the body. If patient stops dialysis of the blood, the waste products will accumulate which could lead to chronic renal failure. Therefore, regular dialysis is required of patient's survival.

The amount of time for dialysis and low long.

For patients with acute renal failure, it takes usually about 4-6 hours, 2-3 times a week depending on the level of waste and the individual health of a patient. For patients with end stage chronic renal failure, the frequency of dialysis in 3 times a week which is determined by the patient's heart and the medical symptoms.

Side effects of dialysis.

During treatment with dialysis, patients with kidney disease, unusual symptoms may occur such as debilitating fatigue, irritability and stress. These are often caused by poor physical condition. Relatives should keep in mind and understand this feeling of defeat and despair.
